Federal Stimulus Funds- America Rescue Plan (ARP) through 9/30/2024

The third phase of the federal stimulus funding is the ARP (Federal American Rescue Plan) which will provide an additional funding of \$2.1 million to Cambridge CSD through 9/30/2024 under the state administered grant process. Cambridge Central School District's allocation under the American Rescue Plan (ARP Act) Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) totals \$2,184,436 of one-time funding to be spent through September 2024. Of the total funds \$1,070,518 is reserved and directed by the state for Learning Loss, Summer Enrichment Grants, and Comprehensive After School Grants. The district must select and implement evidence-based activities and interventions which address the learning loss due to the pandemic.

The administration team has reviewed the results of the school community survey on the use of the federal funds, which was sent out before the start of the school year. Respondents of the survey support the use of the Federal Funds towards Academic Support Services, Mental Health & Social Emotional Support Services, COVID Preparedness Supports for in- person learning, and Technology needs. The district administration team is in the processes of completing the grant application for the use of the onetime funds in these key areas through 9/30/2024. Below is a list of possible expenditures for the state reserve grant in the allowable concentration areas supporting the community survey responses.
